

To all international tourists visiting
Miyakojima

Please read before visiting a medical institution
due to illness or injury.



1. If you get ill or injured during your stay in Miyakojima City and visit a medical institution in the city for consultation, please provide a copy of your passport and your credit card.
2. When traveling, it is always recommended to have travel insurance that covers adequately any medical expenses. Some travel insurances can be applied on the day of departure, before entering Japan. If you do not have insurance, You may be charged high-cost medical expenses in some case (Example: If you are admitted to the intensive care unit, medical expenses may be in increments of millions of yen).
3. Installment payment for medical expenses is not accepted. Even if you have insurance, you will have to pay the full amount once.
4. Please refrain from having unnecessary or non-urgent consultations. Please consult with medical institutions that provide comprehensive medical examination, medical checkup, physical examination, etc. if you need a medical stay visa.
5. Assistance at Miyako Hospital is as follows:
 - a. As a rule, any non-emergency medical treatment is not accepted.
 - b. If you cannot decide whether it is an emergency or non-emergency, please consult the Regional Coordination Office after preparing a referral letter from the ship's doctor etc. For emergencies during holiday nights, please go to the emergency room.
 - c. Miyako Hospital does not support medical tourism or medical checkups.
